return soon to to. Sister Rachel says
they are determined to go to the valley
next spring to to went over to Moses
Davis, ¹⁸⁷⁶ wrote a letter to send to sister
Sarah Maria, who is come to in the evening,
Moses took Franklin, Thebe Ann, & myself
in the sled to My Nephews George Woolley
where we spent the evening had supper
to, Eli & Susan met us there, Franklin
& I went home with them, got to bed

Came back read them, &c. After supper, we went over to Methodist meeting thinking it would be their last, I intended to appoint a meeting for tomorrow night, but they appointed one for that time after saying positively that to night would be the last. I left word to have one given out for Thursday night if they stopped before that. Came with Moses, got to bed before 12 o'clock. Cloudy, snowed some. The minister (Mr. Dunlepp) took his text Mat. 28th - 20th latter clause, "Lo! I am with you always even unto the end of the world". he done better than they commonly do.

In 12th About the house, (Moses Davis) untill 3 o'clock P.M. Wrote a letter to Pres^t Geo. Taylor asking his council what step to take with Bro. Amos Snuff, when I return to Delaware, as he has

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married a yellow girl since I left,
I would say take his priesthood from
him & let him remain in the Church,
but I thought best to seek council
on it before acting. At 3 o'clock P.M., Franklin
& I started to Oli's called half an hour or so at
Mary's barn meters (Jesse's widow) talked Mormonism
to her & son a little, came on to Oli's, stopped
all night, went to bed after 11 o'clock
blowing most of the day, cold;

11th A.M. commenced to write a letter to
my Bro. J. M. Woolley, talked some ~~and~~
eat some apples &c. P.M. at 4 o'clock
started to Chambersburgh to fill
an appointment of meeting, stopped
at Mr. Nutt's until meeting time
(6 o'clock) Franklin preached on
the first principals of the gospel,
done first rate, & spoke about

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They were all well, the weather still
continued cold here, they were dated,
March 9th & 11th / 56, My Niece Hannah
wrote some in Susans letter,

I also received one written by sister
Sarah Maria Mousley, & sent to me
to Philada. but I left before it
came, so it was sent down,

Bro Smith came up from Stanton
stayed all night & I administered
to sister Sarah Maria, for her hand.

Sub 16th. At 10 o'clock held Council
meeting, cut two off from the Church
Wm Knopp for contempt of Council,
& Marrying a yellow girl, he being
an Elder in the Church, & [redacted]
[redacted] for committing Adultery
with [redacted] he also was an
Elder, I gave him a regular scolding
on it, I talked near an hour showing

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the evils & warning the rest not to
be caught in the same manner &
I put it on him solid, I did it for his
own good, I told him he could not be
baptized again before his wife came
at least, he knows the gospel is
true, & I guess he has repented, of
the deed, I feel sorry for all of them
& their families & all. Bro Knapp, was
not there. At 2 o'clock held meeting
in the Hall, only two in except mem-
bers, I preached to them about or over
an hour or perhaps $\frac{3}{4}$ hour, I had a
good degree of the spirit, talked easy.
The church sustained what the coun-
cil did, the Brethren administered
the sacrament, after which in
connection with Bro Cherrington
& Tyres, blessed his (Tyres) child
& three of Sister Margaret's, carpenter's.
