

Lyon, Winsor Palmer
was born 1818 in Maine ^{or Vermont} the son of Aaron Galus Lyon, and
to he joined the Church at an early day and later settled in Nauvoo
Ill., acted as a doctor and a physician or surgeon in the Nauvoo Legion
married Sylvia Porter Sessions, by whom he had several children ^{3 or 4} ~~at Nauvoo~~
he saw Thos. B. Marsh, once a member of the Society, and was ~~his fellow sufferer~~
from the Church; later he returned to the Church and remained faithful
for a short time, but finally removed to Iowa City where he died
about 1849.

Sessions, Sylvia Porter, wife of Winsor Palmer Lyon, was born
July 31, 1818, in Bethel, Caspary Co., Maine, the daughter of
Sessions.
Became a convert to "Mormonism" and was named ^{after} ~~to~~ Mr. Lyon
When he left the Church she was sealed to the Prophet Joseph
Smith. Her children were ^{nine in} ~~seven~~ number, the first one Maria
Ann born in 1839. After the death of Lyon she married Ezekiel
Clark, to whom she bore three children. She left Mr. Clark and
migrated to Utah in 1854 with her brother Perryman Sessions,
and ~~settled~~ with her four children. She settled in Nauvoo when
she died April 13, 1882. Three of her children died in Nauvoo.
