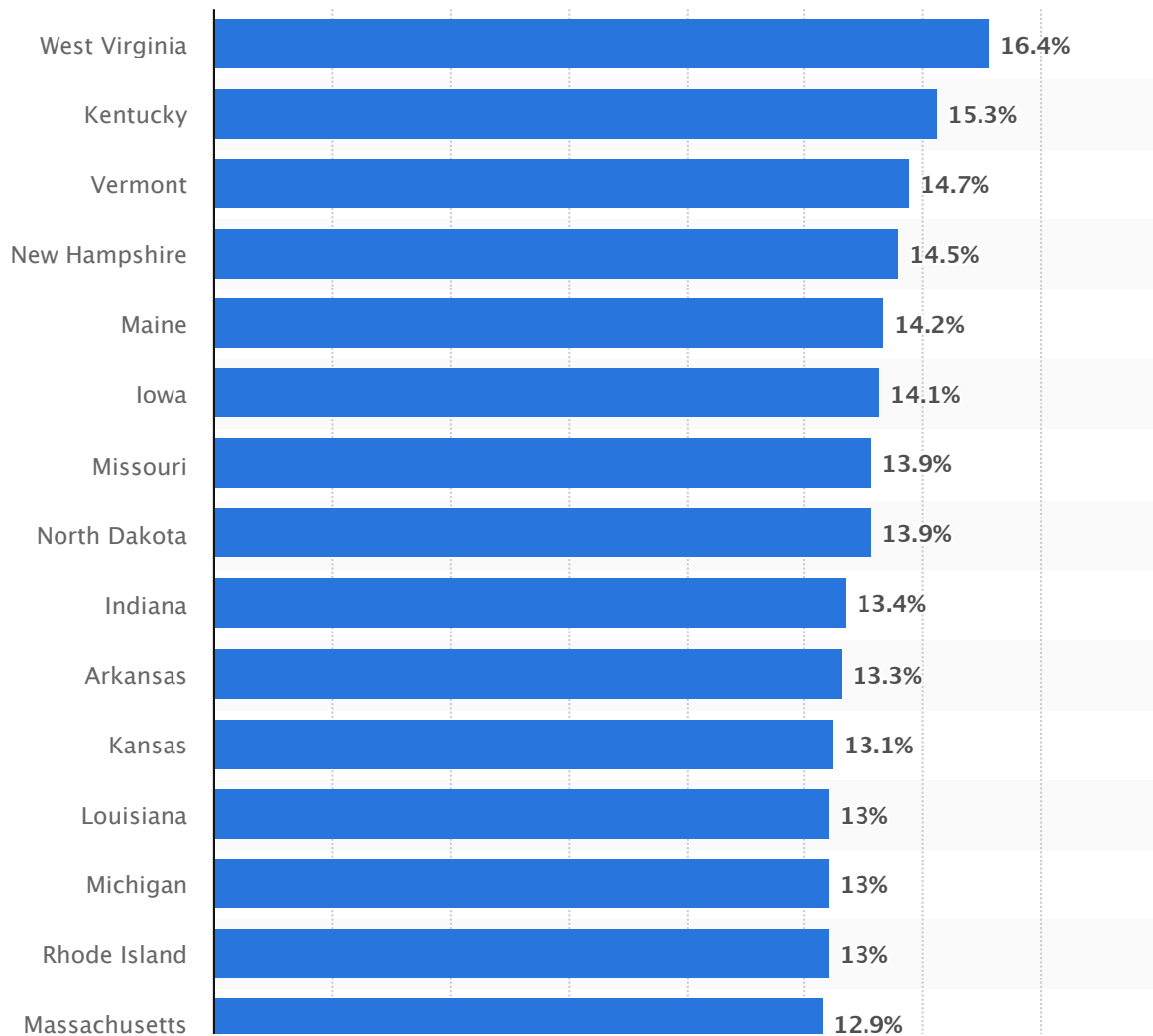

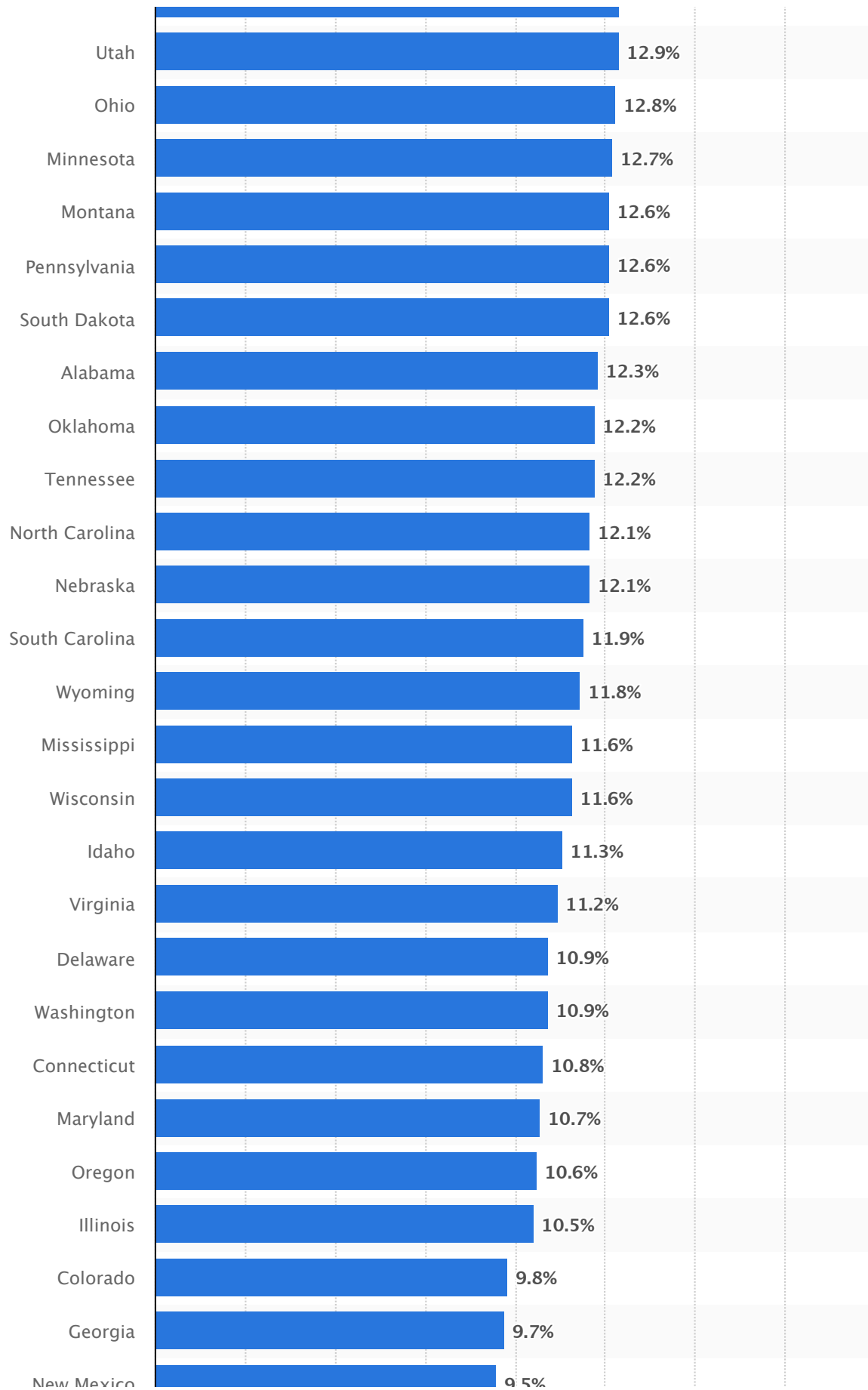
Share of patients in the U.S. taking antidepressants in 2019, by state

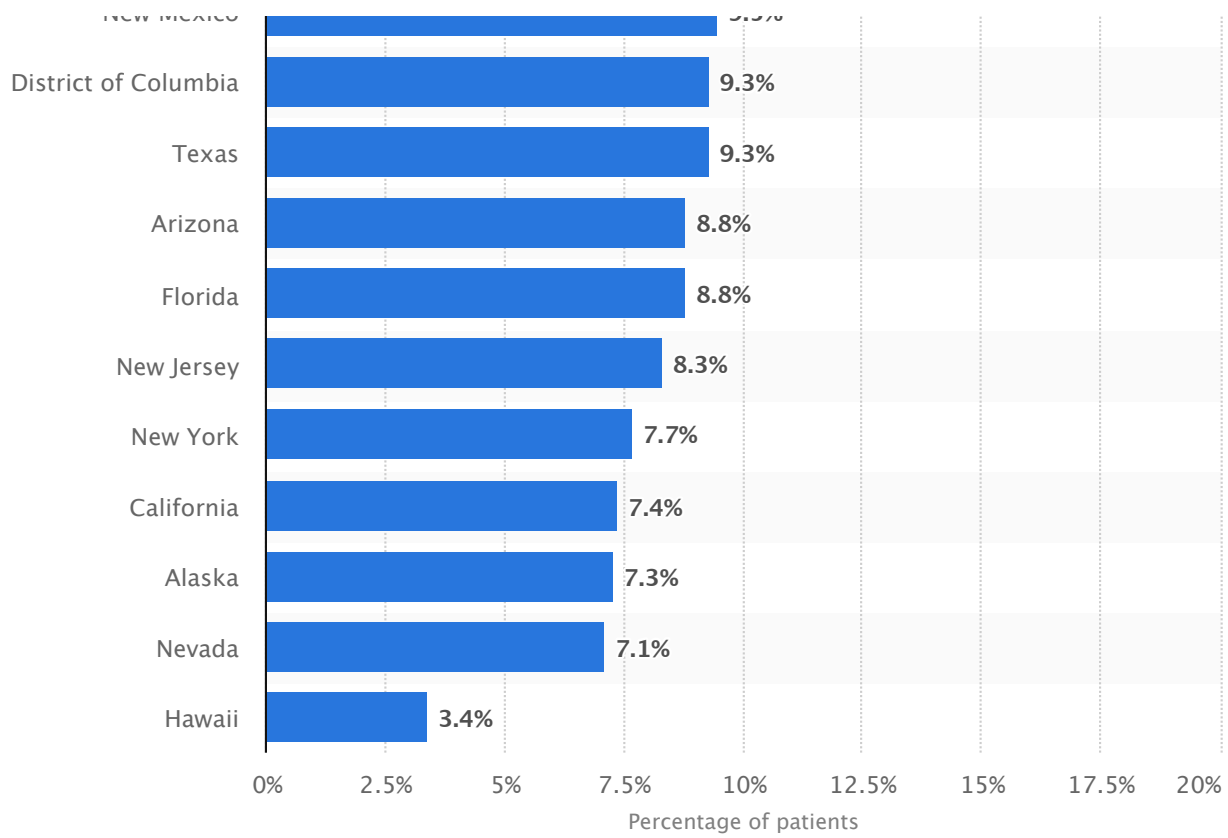
