

Jan 20 1905 I am having halving corn yet  
 The Realty Society got up a big party to get  
 means for the purpose of getting coal to hairy  
 people as it is a hard matter to get clothing  
 on such occasions as we are 50 miles from any  
 rail road & 35 miles to where they can buy  
 much of the stores here are small & don't keep  
 much but supplies for 26 Brother Flecker bluffs  
 just returned from his mission in the Southern  
 States in Kansas he preached to us & gave us  
 some of his experience Sunday 5 payday

We had a enjoyable time & there was a  
 great many testimonies here 7 Feb it snowed  
 20 inches then cleared up 10 Feb rained & sleet 2 day  
 & the country is all a plate there wasnt any  
 meeting 12 on account of the storm

Tuesday 14 I went to quarry with lumber it stormed  
 & the river was up I sent apostle Stasdale  
 & he blessed me & have started up a trade  
 & am trying to handle the product for the people  
 near the 4 moved Floretta in a place north of  
 town in a 2 room frame house it is quite a  
 neat little house it still rains the Sec of the  
 School Maria barling resigned her room

She is going to move away & we put sister  
 Sarah Shaffer in her place Mar 12 I and  
 Jester B. Farnsworth went out to Chiluckpa as  
 home missionaries we visited the Sunday school  
 & had meeting in the afternoon & a special  
 testimony meeting at night we enjoyed  
 the spirit of the Lord very much  
 it stormed on us all the way home

20 there has been some talk and discussion  
 on the god head & I and Bro H. M. bluffs  
 was called to make a special visit to all  
 the people who had advocated that doctrine

that addams is god & the father of christ  
 was false & to day in meeting all forgiven  
 and work for probation & if they did not repent  
 they would be draped from these partitions  
 in the Ward the weather is fine & it looks  
 like summer & have just planted out some  
 gooseberries & cures. Bro Jones has bought  
 Jerry harling's farm & lots & intends  
 moving. Up hear & am doing some  
 hauling. Lumber 27 mo. Brother Colletons came  
 home 28 I started to Jones with lumber  
 going down the mountain & broke my wagon wheel  
 & had to leave out of my load of lumber it snowed  
 6 inches apr. 3 brought some goods home with me  
 Friday 14 of Bro Whitten returned back to his work on the  
 P.D. Sunday to day 23 Matilda was put in as assistant  
 Librarian of the Garcia Sunday School & snowed  
 last night 23 & preached to day on obedience to the authority  
 over us & may I have been down to Dublin & got  
 some more goods for the store 7 of may heaver  
 Leuffy Jr was called & set apart as second assistant  
 in the S.S. school in William Jantz place as miles  
 was away for some time & under the Dr. care  
 sat & may planted corn had 3 teams hauled & got  
 most of my corn in in one day haven't got  
 all my corn gathered from last years crop  
 yet may 7 planted corn & hired 3 teams & put  
 most of my corn in in one day may the 8 started  
 to the station brought back goods for my store  
 may the 13 planted my potatoes may <sup>the</sup> 15 went over to  
 hop Daley to work for J.H. Jones & I hired  
 Dail Humphrey to work for me  
 may 27 Well I have been plowing for J.H. Jones  
 too Oaks & have just returned home &  
 the wind is blowing quite hard the ground  
 is drying out quite fast & the country is looking
