

Decr 27.

At 35 minutes past 9 P.M. there was a council of the Twelve - which continued until about 11 o'clock, at which a selection was made of men and women to labor in the temple the ensuing year. The list is as follows - viz;

Sunday December 28th 1845
Meeting at half past 10 o'clock this
day in the attic story of the Temple, for
those who came to clothe themselves in
the garments of Priesthood. A very
large congregation was present; the pews
seats were some of them filled, the outer
rows withdrawn, and the other pews besides
the pulpit room were filled. - About 200
persons were present, clothed in priestly
garments. Pres. Young addressed the
meeting it having been opened by singing
by S. P. Hale, & Singing the song of Zion,
"The morning breaks the shadows flee" &
"Come to me" &c. Pres. Young came into
the room at 1/4 before 12 M^h. - He said
he supposed those present were a part of
those who have received their endowment;
that they were those who desired to be made
and do honor to the cause they have espoused
and bring reproach upon the character
of him who has given us of thy things. Of
his kingdom forever. The keys or signs
of the Priesthood are for the purpose of
imposing on the minds the order of the
creation - In the first place the name of
this man is given a new name, Adam,
signifying the first man or Eve, the first
woman - Adam's name was more ancient
than his - it was the name of a man
long before Cain, who enjoyed the priesthood.
The new name should be after some ancient
man - Thus with your ancient names,

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from modern praece, and the name that
was just given you, you inquire concerning
things past present & future -

After his fall, another praece was given to
Adam, and being full of integrity, and
not disposed to follow the woman now,
listen to her was permitted to receive the
tokens of the priesthood.

I wish you to clear talking about what you
see and hear in this place. No man or
woman has a right to mention a word
of the appearance of this building in the
least, nor to give the signs & tokens except
when assembled together, according to the
order of the Priesthood, which it is an upper
praece. There are not a dozen persons that can
give the sign & token correct - & the reason is
that person must be to that place, one of
the most sacred places on the face of the
earth that has not understood the right
manner of giving the signs & tokens.

The order and ordinances passed through him
from the principles taught in the Bible -
First when she a love then God supremely
Promised never get back, unless she
follows the man back - if the man have
followed the woman he woule have followed
her down until this time - Of late, liberty
Chappiness will never shine upon men until
they learn these principles - The man must
love his God & the woman must love her
husband - The love which David & Jonathan
had for each other from the love of the priesthood

Jesus is a personage of Tabernacle - the Son
is a personage of Tabernacle - The Spirit

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a Holy Ghost is also a personage, but not
a personage of Tabernacle, but is a personage
of spirit - God dwells in eternal buring
puts his hand through the vail & writes
on the wall - Every person that goes through
these ordinances, unless their hearts & spirits
themselves, I sanctify the Lord, it will
damn them - When you begin again
I shall speak those that are worthy -
We shall not be able to have another public
meeting here on account of the weight
on the floor, it has already caused the
walls to crack - prevents the doors from
shutting, and will injure the roof
I see here 200 persons, all clothed in their
garments, and tomorrow I suppose we
cannot find half enough to work with,
unless we lay an embargo on your garments
onto, and forbid any of you carrying
away your garments. When we begin
we could dress a company of 30, now we
cannot dress 18. For my right arm I
would say ^{say} that every body is honest.
for I do not believe they are -
